House Bill No. 66

(By MR. SPEAKER, MR. AMOS, and MR. DAVIS)

[Passed February 14, 1947; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact chapter one hundred sixty-eight, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-five, relating to the authorization of the judge of the thirteenth judicial circuit of West Virginia to appoint a law assistant, fixing his qualifications and salary, and requiring the county court of Kanawha county to provide the manner of payment of such salary.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That chapter one hundred sixty-eight, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-five, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1. *Law Assistant for Thirteenth Judicial Circuit; Qualifications; Salary.*—On or after the effective date of this act, the judge of the circuit court of Kanawha

4 county, West Virginia, (thirteenth judicial circuit), may
5 appoint a law assistant who shall be a person duly licensed
6 to practice law in this state, and who shall discharge such
7 secretarial duties as may be assigned to him by the judge;
8 said law assistant, while acting as such, shall not engage
9 in the practice of law but shall devote his time to the
10 duties of his office, and may be removed and his suc-
11 cessor appointed at any time by the judge. Said law as-
12 sistant shall receive a salary of not less than four thou-
13 sand two hundred dollars nor more than five thousand
14 dollars per year, to be fixed by the county court, payable
15 monthly, and the county court of Kanawha county shall
16 annually, at its levy session, provide for the payment out
17 of general county funds the amount of the salary so fixed.
