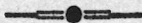

[Passed March 8, 1947; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article one, chapter thirty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, by adding thereto a new section, numbered six-a, relating to engineering corporations.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article one, chapter thirty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended by adding thereto a new section, numbered six-a, to read as follows:

Section 6-a. *Engineering Corporations.*—After the effective date of this act, no corporation shall be chartered in this state under any name which includes the word “engineer,” “engineers,” “engineering” or any combination of the same, unless the purpose of the corporation is to practice professional engineering as defined by chap-

7 ter thirty, article thirteen of the code of West Virginia,  
8 as amended, and one or more of the incorporators is a  
9 registered professional engineer as therein defined.
