[Passed March 8, 1947; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to compensate Achilles T. Robison for loss of a leg and to reimburse him for medical and hospital expenses incurred as a result of gun wounds inflicted upon him by an escaped convict from a prison road camp.

WHEREAS, On May sixth, one thousand nine hundred fortyfour, Achilles T. Robison, of near New Martinsville, West Virginia, was shot in his own home by a convict who, through the
gross and inexecusable negligence of the Deputy Warden and
guards then servants and employees of the State of West Virginia, had escaped from the Reader Road Camp; and,

Whereas, Because of such attack, Achilles T. Robison suffered irreparable injury, including the loss of a leg, and necessarily incurred certain medical and hospital expenses; and,

Whereas, Achilles T. Robison was in no sense at fault; therefore,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Appropriation for Achilles T. Robison.—It
