(By MR. ALLEN)

[Passed March 8, 1947: in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to provide compensation to Charles W. Neville for damages sustained by him in the wrecking and overturning of a truck of the West Virginia Conservation Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1.—There is hereby appropriated, it appearing  
2 from the budget that there is sufficient revenue available  
3 for the purpose, the sum of nine hundred fifty-five dol-  
4 lars, to compensate Charles W. Neville for damages sus-  
5 tained by him in the wrecking and overturning of a truck  
6 of the West Virginia Conservation Commission, being  
7 used at the time in the work of the commission, and in  
8 which he was riding at the invitation, knowledge, and  
9 consent of the driver of said truck and of the local game  
10 protector, also riding in said truck, both being employees


11 and engaged in the work of said commission, said wreck-  
12 ing being caused solely by the reckless and negligent  
13 driving of said truck by the said driver.

Sec. 2. *Finding of Moral Obligation.*—It is hereby de-  
2 clared to be the finding of the legislature, based upon its  
3 conclusion of fact, that the appropriation made in section  
4 one hereof is for a public purpose and for the payment of  
5 a moral obligation of the State of West Virginia.

I certify that the foregoing act,  
having been presented to the Governor for  
his approval, and not having been returned  
by him to the House of the Legislature in  
which it originated within the time pre-  
scribed by the constitution of the State, has  
become a law without his approval.
