Senate Bill No. 307

(By MR. EDDY)

[Passed March 4, 1947; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section six, article one-a, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the revenue accruing from coal stripping at the West Virginia Industrial School for Boys.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section six, article one-a, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 6. *Sale of Excess Farm and Dairy Products;*
2 *Expenditure of Receipts Directed and Restricted; Revenue*
3 *from Coal Stripping at the West Virginia Industrial School*
4 *for Boys.*—The state board of control shall direct the sale
5 of farm and dairy products of farms operated at the

6 various state institutions, but only those products may be
7 sold which cannot be consumed in the institution at which
8 they are produced. The board shall endeavor to sell ex-
9 cess products to other state institutions.

10 The board of control is authorized to deposit all revenue
11 heretofore or hereafter accruing from coal stripping on
12 the farm of the West Virginia industrial school for boys
13 at Pruntytown, West Virginia, in the farm sales fund of
14 that institution. Such revenues, after they have been de-
15 posited in such fund, may be used as other moneys author-
16 ized by law deposited in such fund: *Provided*, That noth-
17 ing contained in this section shall affect the validity of
18 said coal stripping transactions.
