Senate Bill No. 324

(BY MR. JACKSON, of Logan)

[Passed March 8, 1947; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT authorizing the department of unemployment compensation to refund an erroneous payment made by D. W. Lacy.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Department of Unemployment Compensation Authorized to Refund Erroneous Payment.*—The department of unemployment compensation is hereby authorized if it finds it proper to make a refund to D. W. Lacy of nine hundred eight dollars and forty-four cents, the net proceeds of the amount erroneously paid by him in April, one thousand nine hundred forty-five, in satisfaction of an execution issued on two judgments in favor of the department against the Peytona Lumber company, incorporated, and applied by the department on the delinquent account of the Peytona Lumber company, incorporated, such pay-


12 ment having been made by said D. W. Lacy under the
13 mistaken belief that payment of these judgments was
14 necessary in order to protect his rights in certain personal
15 property purchased by him from a trustee under a deed
16 of trust on such property, whereas in fact the property so
17 purchased was not subject to any lien on account of such
18 judgments, the Legislature finding that this refund is
19 necessary to discharge a moral obligation of the state.

I certify that the foregoing act,
having been presented to the Governor for
his approval, and not having been returned
by him to the House of the Legislature in
which it originated within the time pre-
scribed by the constitution of the state, has
become a law without his approval.
