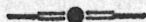

[Passed March 8, 1947; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section seven, article six, chapter eight-a, of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to consolidation of municipalities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seven, article six, chapter eight-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 7. *Endorsement of Certificate; Filing.*—If a
2 majority of the votes cast by the qualified voters in each
3 of the municipalities are shown by the county court's certificate to have voted in favor of the consolidation, the
4 circuit court or judge, if satisfied as to the correctness of
5 the returns evidenced by that certificate, shall so certify
6 upon the certificate. He shall cause the same to be filed

8 forthwith in the office of the clerk of the county court,
9 and to be published in a newspaper of general circula-
10 tion in the municipalities so voting.
