AN ACT to amend and reenact section seven, article six, chapter eight-a, of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to consolidation of municipalities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seven, article six, chapter eight-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 7. Endorsement of Certificate; Filing.-If a

- 2 majority of the votes cast by the qualified voters in each
- 3 of the municipalities are shown by the county court's cer-
- 4 tificate to have voted in favor of the consolidation, the
- 5 circuit court or judge, if satisfied as to the correctness of
- 6 the returns evidenced by that certificate, shall so certify
- 7 upon the certificate. He shall cause the same to be filed

- 8 forthwith in the office of the clerk of the county court,
- 9 and to be published in a newspaper of general circula-
- 10 tion in the municipalities so voting.
