[Passed March 8, 1947; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one-x, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, fixing the time for holding the regular terms of court for the twenty-fourth judicial circuit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one-x, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1-x. *Twenty-fourth Circuit.*—For the county
2 of Mingo, on the first Monday in January, May and Sep-
3 tember.
4 For the county of Wayne, on the second Monday in
5 March and July, and the fourth Monday in November.
