[Passed March 8, 1947; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article eleven, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to airports and aviation, by adding thereto a new section designated as number fifteen, permitting Mingo county and any city, town or village therein to expend public funds for an airport or landing field in the state of Kentucky.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article eleven, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred forty-three, be amended by adding thereto a new section, numbered section fifteen, to read as follows:

Section 15. Mingo county and any city, town or village
2 in said county may acquire in the state of Kentucky real
3 property necessary for an airport or landing field by pur-

4 chase or lease, and may establish, construct, equip, main-
5 tain and operate on such real property such airport or
6 landing field for use of aeroplanes and other aircraft.
7 The purchase or lease price for any real property so
8 acquired and the cost of establishing, constructing, equip-
9 ping, maintaining and operating any such airport or land-
10 ing field may be paid for by appropriation of moneys
11 available therefor or wholly or partly from the proceeds
12 of the sale of bonds of such county, city, town or village,
13 or the bonds of the county, and any one or more of the
14 cities, towns and villages in said county, as the county
15 court or legislative body shall determine, subject, how-
16 ever, to the provisions of general law for the issuance and
17 sale of bonds of counties and municipalities for public
18 purposes generally.

I certify that the foregoing act,
having been presented to the Governor for
his approval, and not having been returned
by him to the House of the Legislature in
which it originated within the time pre-
scribed by the constitution of the state, has
become a law without his approval.
