AN ACT to repeal section nineteen-b, article eight, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as last amended, relating to the use of highways by motor vehicles, carrying other vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Section nineteen-b, article eight, chapter 2 seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine 3 hundred thirty-one, as last amended by chapter eighty-4 eight, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thous-5 and nine hundred thirty-nine, is hereby repealed. Enr. S. B. No. 73]
