[Passed February 14, 1947; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section three, article three, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to the manner and method of sale of county and district owned property.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article three, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 3. *Sale of County or District Property.*—In
2 all instances where the county court of a county is by
3 law authorized to sell or dispose of any property, either
4 real or personal, belonging to the county or held by it for
5 the use of any district thereof, the same shall be sold at
6 public auction, at the front door of the courthouse of the
7 county, and such sale shall be conducted by the president

8 of the county court, but before making any such sale,
9 notice of the time, terms and place of sale shall be given
10 by publication thereof once each week for two consecu-
11 tive weeks in some newspaper of general circulation in
12 said county, which notice shall contain a brief description
13 of the property to be sold: *Provided, however,* That this
14 section shall not apply to the sale of any one item of
15 property of less value than one thousand dollars: *Pro-*
16 *vided, further,* That the provisions of this section con-
17 cerning sale at public auction shall not apply to a county
18 court selling or disposing of its property for a public use
19 to the State of West Virginia, or its political subdivisions,
20 including county boards of education, for an adequate
21 consideration without considering alone the present com-
22 mercial or market value of the property.
