[Passed February 18, 1947; in effect July 1, 1947.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section thirteen, article two, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, and to amend such article by adding thereto a new section to be designated section thirteen-a, relating to the powers and duties of the state board of education in respect to state educational institutions and to the transfer of property and financial control of such institutions from the state board of control to the state board of education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section thirteen, article two, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted, and that such article be amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated section thirteen-a, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 18. EDUCATION**Article 2. State Board of Education**

Section 13. *Powers and Duties of State Board as to*
2 *State Educational Institutions.* The state board shall
3 have general control, supervision and management of the
4 business and educational affairs of Marshall college, Fair-
5 mont state college, West Liberty state college, Glenville
6 state college, West Virginia institute of technology, Shep-
7 herd college, Concord college, West Virginia state college,
8 Bluefield state college, the West Virginia schools for the
9 deaf and the blind, and the West Virginia school for the
10 colored deaf and blind. The state board shall employ the
11 president or principal, and the professors, teachers and
12 other employees of each of the state educational institu-
13 tions under its control and management, and shall fix the
14 yearly or monthly salary to be paid to each person so
15 employed.

Sec. 13-a. *Control of Property and Business Affairs of*
2 *State Educational Institutions.* The control of the finan-
3 cial, business and all other affairs of the state educational
4 institutions named in the preceding section is hereby

5 transferred from the state board of control to the state
6 board of education. The state board of education shall,
7 in respect to the control, management and property of
8 such institutions, have the same rights and powers and
9 shall perform the same duties as were heretofore exer-
10 cised or performed by the state board of control. The
11 title to all property of such institutions is hereby trans-
12 ferred to and vested in the state board of education.
