ENROLLED House Bill No. 22

(By Mr. Speaker, Mr. Amos)

[Passed February 20, 1947; in effect July 1, 1947.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article eleven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the continuation, management and control of West Virginia university and to the constitution, rights, powers and duties of the board of governors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article eleven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 18. EDUCATION

Article 11. West Virginia University

Section 1. Continuation; Board of Governors. The

- 2 West Virginia University, heretofore established and lo-
- 3 cated at Morgantown, in Monongalia county, shall be

continued, and shall be known as "West Virginia University." The business and educational affairs of the university shall be under the control, supervision and management of the board of governors, which shall be a 7 corporation, and as such may contract and be contracted with, sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, and have and use a common seal. The board of governors shall 10 consist of nine members, all of whom shall be citizens of 11 12 the state, to be appointed by the governor, by and with the advice and consent of the senate, for overlapping terms 13 of nine years, except that the original appointments shall 14 be for terms of one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, and nine years, respectively. At least one but not more 16 than two members shall be appointed from each congres-17 sional district and at least four members shall be gradu-18 ates of West Virginia University. No more than five 19 members shall belong to the same political party. No per-20 21son shall be eligible for membership on the board of governors who is a member of any political party executive 22 23 committee, or who holds any other public office or public 24 employment under the federal government or under the

- 25 government of this state or any of its political subdivi-
- 26 sions, or who is an appointee or employee of the board.
- 27 Members shall be eligible for reappointment.
- 28 The governor shall appoint all members of the board of
- 29 governors as soon after the effective date hereof as is
- 30 practicable, for respective terms of office beginning on the
- 31 first day of July, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven.
- 32 Any vacancy on the board of governors shall be filled by
- 33 the governor by appointment for the unexpired term.
- 34 The terms of office of present members of the board of
- 35 governors shall expire on the thirtieth day of June, one
- 36 thousand nine hundred forty-seven.
- 37 No member may be removed from office by the gover-
- 38 nor except for official misconduct, incompetence, neglect
- 39 of duty, or gross immorality, and then only in the man-
- 40 ner prescribed by law for the removal by the governor of
- 41 state elective officers.
- 42 Before exercising any authority or performing any du-
- 43 ties as a member of the board of governors, each member
- 44 shall qualify as such by taking and subscribing to the
- 45 oath of office prescribed by section five, article four of the

- 46 Constitution, the certificate whereof shall be filed in the
- 47 office of the secretary of state. A suitable office or offices
- 48 for the board shall be provided in the buildings of West
- 49 Virginia University.
- 50 The board of governors shall have general control, su-
- 51 pervision and management of the business and educa-
- 52 tional affairs of the university and of Potomac state school,
- 53 and shall have full authority to employ all officers, teach-
- 54 ers and other employees of such institutions and fix their
- 55 yearly or monthly salaries.
- 56 The board of governors shall meet annually in June at
- 57 the university in the performance of its duties, and may
- 58 meet at such other times and places as may be necessary
- 59 for the best interests of the institutions under its control.
- 60 Special meetings may be called by the board when in ses-
- 61 sion, or by the president, who shall not succeed himself
- 62 as president, of the board. The board shall at each annual
- 63 meeting elect one of its members as president and one
- 64 as vice-president of the board, and shall appoint a secre-
- 65 tary and fix his salary, the same to be paid out of the
- 66 funds apropriated by the legislature for the university.

The president of the university shall be the chief execu-67 tive officer of the board. The members of the board shall 68 69 serve without compensation, but every member shall be 70 reimbursed from the appropriation made by the legisla-71 ture for the support of the university for actual expenses 72 incident to the performance of his duties, upon presenta-73 tion of an itemized sworn statement, thereof. 74 On the first day of October of each year, or as soon 75 thereafter as practicable, the board of governors shall make to the governor and to the legislature a full report 76

concerning the educational institutions under its control

and management, together with its recommendations in

79 respect to needed legislation.
