### House Bill No. 36

(Originating in the Committee on Education.)

[Passed February 20, 1947; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section thirteen-a, article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the employment by county boards of education of directors and supervisors of instruction.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section thirteen-a, article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted, to read as follows:

Section 13-a. *Employment of Directors and Supervisors*  
2 of *Instruction*.— The board, subject to the provisions of  
3 this chapter and the rules and regulations of the state  
4 board, shall have authority to employ such directors or  
5 supervisors of instruction as may be deemed necessary,

6 their compensation to be paid from any fund of the board  
7 available for the purpose.

8 The employment of band directors, playground direc-  
9 tors, playground supervisors, athletic coaches, and other  
10 directors and supervisors may be on a twelve month  
11 basis.
