AN ACT to amend article three, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section to be designated section nine-a, relating to the authority of the state superintendent of schools in respect to the correction of fire hazards and other unsafe conditions in public school buildings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article three, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated section nine-a, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 18. EDUCATION

Article 3. State Superintendent of Schools

Section 9-a. Authority of State Superintendent in Re-2 spect to Safety of Buildings.—"Whenever any county

- 3 board shall fail to comply with an order of the state fire
- 4 marshal for correction of fire hazards in any public school
- 5 building, the state superintendent shall close the build-
- 6 ing, or the unsafe part thereof, until the board complies
- 7 with such order. The state superintendent shall also
- 8 have the power and authority to inspect any public
- 9 school building and to order the making of such repairs
- 10 or alterations as may be necessary to put the building
- 11 into a safe condition.
