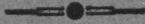

**Senate Bill No. 280**

(By MR. BOREMAN and MR. JOHNSTON)

[Passed March 8, 1947; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article seven, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the salary of certain state officers.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section two, article seven, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2. *Salaries of Certain State Officers.*—The salary of the governor shall be ten thousand dollars per annum.

The salary of the attorney general shall be seventy-five hundred dollars per annum, effective from and after the first Monday after the second Wednesday in January in the year one thousand nine hundred forty-nine, the sal-

8 ary of the auditor, the secretary of state, the treasurer,  
9 the commissioner of agriculture, and the superintendent  
10 of free schools, shall be each, six thousand dollars per  
11 annum.

12 The salary of each of the judges of the supreme court  
13 of appeals shall be twelve thousand five hundred dollars  
14 per annum.
