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House Bill No. 105
(By MR. SPEAKER, MR. FLANNERY)

[Passed March 5, 1949; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section eight, article ten, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the acceptance and disbursement of future federal funds allocated to the state for educational purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eight, article ten, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted, to read as follows:

Section 8. *Acceptance and Disbursement of Future Federal Funds Allocated to State.*—The state board of education is hereby authorized and empowered to accept for the State of West Virginia, and expend for the purpose designated, any funds that may hereafter be made available to

6 the board out of the federal treasury by an act or acts of
7 congress and allocated to this state for vocational educa-
8 tion, or for the use or benefit of the state colleges and
9 other state institutions under the direct control and su-
10 pervision of the board, or for any other educational pur-
11 pose.

12 * The state superintendent of free schools is hereby au-
13 thorized and empowered to accept for the state of West
14 Virginia any funds that may hereafter be made available
15 to the state department of education or to the state super-
16 intendent of free schools out of the federal treasury by an
17 act or acts of Congress for current expense, capital out-
18 lay, free textbooks, or any other educational purpose in
19 local public school units, or for any other educational
20 purpose.

21 Subject to the provisions and conditions of applicable
22 federal law with respect to the allocation and distribution
23 of any federal funds for current expense purposes in local
24 public school units, the state board of school finance is
25 hereby authorized and empowered to allocate and dis-

26 tribute said federal funds in accordance with the follow-
27 ing provisoinis:

28 1. Of said federal funds received, seventy-one per cent
29 shall be allocated for teachers' salaries and the distribu-
30 tion to each county board of education shall be made on
31 the basis of actual teachers employed at the end of the
32 second month of the current school term and said allocated
33 share of such funds shall be used in said county for the
34 purpose of adding to the present minimum legal salaries
35 the following increments:

36 (a) Ten dollars per month for all teachers holding
37 emergency certificates based on less than two years of
38 college training.

39 (b) Twenty-five dollars per month for all teachers hold-
40 ing regular certificates based on less than four years of
41 college training and all teachers holding emergency cer-
42 tificates based on two or more years of college training.

43 (c) Sixty-five dollars per month for all teachers holding
44 regular certificates based on college degrees.

45 All such increments may be reduced or increased on a
46 proportionate basis in accordance with the amount of

47 funds available under the seventy-one per cent allocation.

48 2. The balance of said federal funds, the equivalent of
49 twenty-nine per cent of said funds, shall be distributed
50 among the several counties. Such distribution shall be
51 based on the net enrollment for the fourth school month
52 of the current year and determined on a ratio that said
53 net enrollment of each county bears to the total net en-
54 rollment of the state.
