## House Bill No. 236

(By Mr. Campbell, (of Cabell) by request)

[Passed March 12, 1949; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article two, chapter thirty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section to be designated section thirty-eight, relating to the imposition of a tax upon annuity considerations received by life insurance companies.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article two, chapter thirty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirty-eight, to read as follows:

Section 38. Every life insurance company licensed to

- 2 transact business in this state shall make a return an-
- 3 nually, on or before the first day of March, to the insurance
- 4 commissioner, under the oath of its president or secretary,

of the gross amount of annuity considerations collected and received by it during the previous calendar year on business done in this state; and upon receiving from the commissioner a certificate of the acceptance of such return and of the amount of tax due thereon, such company shall pay such tax to the insurance commissioner annually 10 on or before the first day of March. The annual tax which 11 a licensed insurance company is required to pay to the state on such considerations shall be a sum equal to one 13 per centum of the gross amount of annuity considerations 14 received by it on the business written or renewed in this state, less annuity considerations returned and less ter-16 mination allowances on group annuity contracts. All such taxes paid to the commissioner shall be paid by him 18 into the state treasury for the benefit of the state fund. The tax imposed by this act shall be first payable in 20 21 the year one thousand nine hundred forty-nine, on the basis of taxable annuity considerations collected and 22 23 received by insurance companies during the year one 24 thousand nine hundred forty-eight.
