[Passed February 17, 1949; in effect July 1, 1949.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact chapter one hundred seventy-one, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven, relating to the authorization of the judge of the thirteenth judicial circuit of West Virginia to appoint a law assistant, fixing his qualifications and salary, and requiring the county court of Kanawha County to provide the manner of payment of such salary.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That chapter one hundred seventy-one, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1. *Law Assistant for Thirteenth Judicial Circuit; Qualifications; Salary.*—On or after the effective
2 date of this act, the judge of the circuit court of Kanawha
3 County, West Virginia, (thirteenth judicial circuit), may
4 appoint a law assistant, who shall be a person duly licensed
5

6 to practice law in this state, and who shall discharge such
7 secretarial duties as may be assigned to him by the judge;
8 said law assistant, while acting as such, shall not engage
9 in the practice of law but shall devote his time to the
10 duties of his office, and may be removed and his successor
11 appointed at any time by the judge. Said law assistant
12 shall receive a salary of not less than five thousand dol-
13 lars nor more than six thousand dollars per year, to be
14 fixed by the county court, payable monthly, and the
15 county court of Kanawha county shall annually, at its
16 levy session, provide for the payment out of general
17 county funds the amount of the salary so fixed.
