AN ACT authorizing and directing the state treasurer to apportion between the city of Huntington and the board of park commissioners of the city of Huntington the share of the city of Huntington in the special fund for aid to municipalities in receipts from the state liquor commission as provided under section nineteen, article three, chapter sixty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to the disposition of receipts of the state liquor control commission in part for reimbursement of municipalities as amended by chapter seventy-one, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-one.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Division of Fund for Aid to Municipalities*  
2 *from Receipts of State Liquor Control Commission Be-*

3 *tween City of Huntington and Huntington Board of*  
4 *Park Commissioners.*—The state treasurer in apportion-  
5 ing money in the special fund for aid to municipalities  
6 established under section nineteen, article three, chapter  
7 sixty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine  
8 hundred thirty-one, as amended by chapter seventy-one,  
9 acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand  
10 nine hundred forty-one, shall hereafter apportion that  
11 part of said fund allocated to the city of Huntington and  
12 pay one-tenth thereof to the board of park commissioners  
13 of the city of Huntington and nine-tenths thereof to the  
14 city of Huntington: *Provided, however,* That no more  
15 than ten thousand dollars shall be allocated to the board  
16 of park commissioners in any one year.
