**House Bill No. 87**

(By MR. McLAUGHLIN, of Braxton)

[Passed March 12, 1949; in effect July 1, 1949.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section eight, article five-a, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as enacted by chapter one hundred forty, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven, relating to salary of the commissioner of the department of motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section eight, article five-a, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as enacted by chapter one hundred forty, acts of the Legislature, regular session, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 8. *Salary and Expenses.*—The commissioner  
2 shall receive a salary of six thousand dollars and the  
3 necessary traveling expenses incident to the performance  
4 of his duties. Requisition for traveling expenses shall be

5 accompanied by a sworn and itemized statement which  
6 shall be filed with the auditor and permanently preserved  
7 as a public record.
