AN ACT finding and declaring certain claims against the state  
and its agencies to be moral obligations of the state, and  
directing the auditor to issue warrants for the payment  
thereof.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Finding and Declaring Certain Claims Against*  
2 *the State and Its Agencies to be Moral Obligations of the*  
3 *State, and Directing Payment Thereof.*—The Legislature  
4 has considered the findings of fact and recommendations  
5 reported to it by the court of claims concerning various  
6 claims against the state and the agencies thereof, and  
7 in respect to each of the following claims the Legislature  
8 adopts those findings of fact as its own and hereby de-

9 clares it to be the moral obligation of the state to pay  
10 each such claim in the amount specified below, and directs  
11 the auditor to issue warrants for the payment thereof  
12 out of any funds appropriated and available for the  
13 purpose.
