[Passed March 4, 1949; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize and empower the county court of Wyoming county to transfer the unexpended balances in the dog tax fund to the general county fund of said county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county court of Wyoming county is
2 hereby authorized and empowered to transfer the unex-
3 pended balances now in the dog tax fund of said county,
4 remaining and not needed for the payment and satisfac-
5 tion of all claims and expenses against the said dog tax
6 fund, to the general county fund of said county.

7 All acts, or parts of acts, inconsistent herewith, are
8 hereby repealed, insofar as they may apply to Wyoming
9 county.
