Senate Bill No. 241

(By MESSRS. MITCHELL AND LOVE)

[Passed March 7, 1949; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section six, article one-A, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the use of the funds in the farm sales fund account at the West Virginia Industrial School for Boys.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section six, article one-A, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 6. *Sale of Excess Farm and Dairy Products;*
2 *Expenditure of Receipts Directed and Restricted; Reve-*
3 *nue from Coal Stripping at the West Virginia Industrial*
4 *School for Boys; Use of Funds in the Farm Sales Fund Ac-*

5 *count.*—The state board of control shall direct the sale of
6 farm and dairy products of farms operated at the various
7 state institutions, but only those products may be sold
8 which cannot be consumed in the institution at which
9 they are produced. The board shall endeavor to sell ex-
10 cess products to other state institutions.

11 The board of control is authorized to deposit all revenue
12 heretofore or hereafter accruing from coal stripping on
13 the farm of the West Virginia industrial school for boys
14 at Pruntytown, West Virginia, in the farm sales fund of
15 that institution. Such revenues, after they have been de-
16 posited in such fund, may be used as other moneys au-
17 thorized by law deposited in such fund: *Provided*, That
18 nothing contained in this section shall affect the validity of
19 said coal stripping transactions.

20 The board of control is further authorized to use from
21 this fund an amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars
22 (\$50,000.00) for the purchase of necessary equipment and
23 furniture for the boys' dormitories now under construc-
24 tion, and for the gymnasium and swimming pool.
