(Originating in the Committee on Education.)

[Passed February 24, 1949; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact article two, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section to be designated section sixteen, relating to the establishment and operation of state camp and conference center for Future Farmers of America, for Future Homemakers of America, and for other educational groups.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article two, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section designated section sixteen, to read as follows:

Section 16. *Establishment and Operation State Camp and Conference Center; Payment of Expense; Gifts and Donations.*—For the purpose of developing competent leadership, developing character, training for useful citizenship, fostering patriotism, and of providing and encouraging the development of organized recreational activities for Future Farmers of America and Future Homemakers of America members, and other youth and adult groups, a camp and conference center is hereby established.

The West Virginia board of education is hereby authorized to secure a site for such camp and conference center at some suitable place and provide the necessary buildings and equipment therefor.

Such camp and conference center shall be operated by the division of vocational education of the West Virginia board of education. Such camp and conference center may be rented for educational purposes only and the rent received therefor shall be deposited in the state treasury and paid out on requisition of the division of vocational education of the West Virginia board of education for the

21 maintenance and operation of such camp and conference
22 center.

23 Any appropriations now or hereafter made by the Leg-
24 islature to carry out the provisions and purposes of this
25 section shall be expended through the West Virginia board
26 of education.

27 The West Virginia board of education is hereby author-
28 ized and empowered to receive and use such gifts and
29 donations of money, land, buildings, materials, equipment,
30 supplies, and labor, either from public or private sources,
31 as may be offered unconditionally or under such condi-
32 tions as in the judgment of the West Virginia board of
33 education are proper and consistent with the provisions of
34 this section.

35 All the money received as gifts and donations, by the
36 West Virginia board of education shall be deposited in
37 the state treasury to be used by the said board of educa-
38 tion in establishing and maintaining the aforesaid camp
39 and conference center. A report of all gifts and donations
40 offered and accepted, together with the names of the
41 donors and the amounts contributed by each and all dis-

42 bursements therefrom shall be submitted annually to the
43 governor of the state by the West Virginia board of edu-
44 cation.
