Senate Bill No. 42

[Originating in the Committee on Claims and Grievances.]

[Passed March 7, 1949; in effect July 1, 1949.]

AN ACT finding and declaring certain claims against the state and its agencies to be moral obligations of the state, and directing the auditor to issue warrants for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The Legislature has considered the findings
2 of fact and recommendations reported to it by the court
3 of claims concerning various claims against the state and
4 the agencies thereof, and in respect to each of the fol-
5 lowing claims the Legislature adopts those findings of
6 fact as its own, and hereby declares it to be the moral
7 obligation of the state to pay each such claim in the

8 amount specified below, and directs the auditor to issue
9 warrants for the payment thereof out of any funds ap-
10 propriated and available for the purpose.
