AN ACT to amend article seven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, numbered forty-three, relating to substitute teacher.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article seven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

Section 43. The Substitute Teacher.—The substitute

- 2 teacher shall be a duly certified teacher and shall receive
- 3 pay, which shall be based upon the certificate held by
- 4 and the experience of said substitute teacher, for said
- 5 service in accordance with the salary schedule of the
- 6 regularly employed teachers in said county. The county
- 7 superintendent, subject to the aproval of the county board
- 8 of education, shall have the authority to assign said sub-

9 stitute teacher to any of the following duties: (a) To fill

10 the temporary absence of any teacher or an unexpired

11 school term made vacant by resignation, death, suspen-

12 sion or dismissal; (b) to fill a teaching position of a reg-

13 ular teacher on leave of absence, and (c) to perform the

14 instructional services of any teacher who is authorized by

15 law to be absent from class without loss of pay, providing

16 such absence is approved by the board of education in

17 accordance with the law.
