House Bill No. 174

(By MR. CAPLAN)

[Passed February 20, 1951; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the state auditor to expend from collections in the operating fund of the land department of the state auditor's office, an amount not to exceed eight thousand dollars for the compiling, printing and sale of an official index to land grants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Expenditure for Printing of Index to Land*

2 *Grants.*—The state auditor is hereby authorized to expend
3 from the operating fund of the land department of the
4 state auditor's office, established by section four, article
5 seven, chapter eleven-a of the code of West Virginia, a
6 sum not to exceed eight thousand dollars, for the com-
7 piling and printing of an official index to original land
8 grants on file in his office. It shall be the duty of the
9 auditor to provide copies of the index for use in the
10 clerk's office of each county in addition to those for use

11 in the land department. The remaining copies may be
12 sold by his office at a price not to exceed fifteen dollars
13 per copy, the proceeds of such sale to be deposited back
14 into the said operating fund.
