AN ACT to repeal section eleven, article four, chapter twenty-seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to examination and treatment of prisoners in penitentiary.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eleven, article four, chapter twenty-seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one be, and hereby is, repealed.


Section 1. *Repeal.*—Section eleven, article four, chapter

4 treatment of prisoners in penitentiary is hereby repealed.






