AN ACT to amend and reenact section eleven, article one, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to clerk, deputy and assistant clerks, compensation, crier and messenger of the supreme court of appeals.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section eleven, article one, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 11. *Clerk; Deputy; Associate; Assistant Proof-reader; Other Clerical Assistants; Compensation; Crier; Messenger.*—The supreme court of appeals, or judges thereof in vacation, may appoint a clerk, who shall give

5 bond as required by article two, chapter six of this code.  
6 The annual compensation of the clerk shall be fixed by  
7 the court, and shall be not less than seven thousand dol-  
8 lars, payable in equal monthly installments out of the  
9 state treasury, and shall be in lieu of all other fees, costs,  
10 allowances, compensation, perquisites and income of  
11 whatever kind by virtue of his office. The supreme  
12 court of appeals, or judges thereof in vacation, may ap-  
13 point one deputy clerk, one associate clerk, one assistant  
14 clerk, one proofreader and such other full-time and part-  
15 time clerical assistants as are deemed necessary to per-  
16 form properly the functions and duties of the office of  
17 the clerk. And the said court or judges thereof in vaca-  
18 tion, shall fix their compensation which shall be payable  
19 out of the biennium appropriations made by the legis-  
20 lature of West Virginia, personal service account, for  
21 the spending unit of the supreme court of appeals, by  
22 requisitions drawn against the auditor of the state of West  
23 Virginia according to law. All of such officers shall be  
24 removable at the pleasure of the court or judges. Va-  
25 cancies in the office of the clerk occurring during vaca-

26 tion may be filled by appointment, in writing, made by  
27 the judges of the court or a majority thereof.
