AN ACT finding and declaring the claim of L. G. Gribble against the State of West Virginia and its agency, the state road commission, to be a moral obligation of the state and directing the auditor to issue a warrant for the payment thereof.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. The legislature has considered the findings  
2 of fact and the recommendations reported by the court of  
3 claims concerning the claim of L. G. Gribble against the  
4 state road commission, such findings of fact and recom-  
5 mendations being contained in the opinion of the said  
6 state court of claims in Case No. 560, said claim being for  
7 trees and rose bushes belonging to the said L. G. Gribble,  
8 negligently cut down by employees of the state road com-

9 mission of West Virginia, and in respect to the said claim  
10 the legislature adopts those findings of fact as its own  
11 and hereby declares it to be the moral obligation of the  
12 state to pay the said claim of L. G. Gribble in the amount  
13 of two hundred fifty dollars, hereby appropriates from  
14 the treasury, state fund, general revenue, the sum of  
15 two hundred fifty dollars in order to pay such claim, and  
16 hereby directs the auditor to issue a warrant for the  
17 payment thereof.
