AN ACT finding and declaring the claim of Benny Salpini against the State of West Virginia and its agency, the adjutant generals department, to be a moral obligation of the state and directing the auditor to issue a warrant for the payment thereof.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. The legislature has considered the claim  
2 of Benny Salpini against the adjutant general's depart-  
3 ment, said claim being for damages to an automobile be-  
4 longing to the said Benny Salpini, caused by the negligent  
5 driving of one William Crouse, a member of the West  
6 Virginia national guard, who drove into the parked car  
7 of said Benny Salpini, and in respect to the said claim the

8 legislature declares it to be the moral obligation of the  
9 state to pay the said claim of Benny Salpini in the amount  
10 of fifty dollars, and hereby appropriates from the treas-  
11 ury, state fund, general revenue, the sum of fifty dollars  
12 in order to pay such claim, and hereby directs the  
13 auditor to issue a warrant for the payments thereof.
