[Passed March 10, 1951; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT finding and declaring the claim of D. K. Hylton against the State of West Virginia to be a moral obligation of the state and directing the auditor to issue a warrant for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The legislature has considered the claim of
2 D. K. Hylton against the state tax commissioner, said
3 claim being for over-payment of business and occupation
4 tax for the last three quarters of one thousand nine hun-
5 dred forty-four and for the years one thousand nine hun-
6 dred forty-five and one thousand nine hundred forty-six,
7 and in respect to the said claim the legislature declares
8 it to be the moral obligation of the state to pay the said

9 claim of D. K. Hylton in the amount of five hundred eight
10 and forty-one one hundredths dollars, and hereby appro-
11 priates from the treasury, state fund, general revenue,
12 the sum of five hundred eight and forty-one one hun-
13 dredths dollars in order to pay such claim, and hereby
14 directs the auditor to issue a warrant for the payment
15 thereof.
