(By Mr. Love)

[Passed March 10, 1951; in effect July 1, 1951.]

AN ACT finding and declaring certain claims against the state and its agencies to be moral obligations of the state, and directing the auditor to issue warrants for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Finding and Declaring Certain Claims*
2 *Against the State Road Commission, the Adjutant Gen-*
3 *eral's Department, the State Board of Control, the State*
4 *Department of Public Assistance and the State Conser-*
5 *vation Commission to Be Moral Obligations of the State,*
6 *and Directing Payment Thereof.*—The legislature has
7 considered the findings of fact and recommendations re-
8 ported to it by the court of claims concerning various

9 claims against the state and the agencies thereof, and in
10 respect to each of the following claims the legislature
11 adopts those findings of fact as its own, and hereby de-
12 clares it to be the moral obligation of the state to pay
13 each such claim in the amount specified below, and di-
14 rects the auditor to issue warrants for the payment
15 thereof out of any fund appropriated and available for
16 the purpose.
