ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 295

(By Mr. Jones)

[Passed March 10, 1951; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section eighteen, article eight, chapter sixty-one, of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to exceptions of labor or employment on Sabbath day.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eighteen, article eight, chapter sixty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 18. Limitation of Preceding Section; Contract

- 2 Made on Sabbath Day Valid.—No forfeiture shall be in-
- 3 curred or conviction had under the preceding section for
- 4 the transportation on the Sabbath day of the mail, or of
- 5 passengers and their baggage carried by any mode of

public conveyance, or for running any railroad train, traction car or system, automobile or other motor car carrying passengers for pleasure or hire, steamboat or other boat used in carrying passengers or freight, manufacturing establishments or any of their employees where 10 the processes of said manufacture require continuous 11 12 operation and where said employees are on rotating 13 shift schedules, on the Sabbath day, or for carrying firearms or shooting on that day, by any person having the right so to do under the laws of the United States or of 15 16 this state; and no forfeiture shall be incurred or conviction had under the preceding section by or of any person who 17 18 conscientiously believes that the seventh day of the week ought to be observed as a Sabbath and actually refrains 19 20 from all secular business and labor on that day, provided he does not compel any apprentice or servant not of his 21 22 belief to do secular work or business on Sunday, and 23 does not on that day disturb any other person in his ob-24 servance of the same. No contract shall be deemed void because it is made on the Sabbath day.
