[Passed March 14, 1953; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article one, chapter fifty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirty-six, relating to fees and allowances when person pecuniarily unable to pay them.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article one, chapter fifty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirty-six, to read as follows:

Section 36. *Fees and Allowances for Poor Persons.*—

2 If a person shall present to the proper collecting officer
3 such person's written statement, certified by the chief
4 executive officer of a duly chartered legal aid society,
5 that he is pecuniarily unable to pay any of the fees and

6 allowances mentioned in this article, he shall be forgiven

7 and not required to pay such costs.
