AN ACT to amend article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirty-four, relating to compensation for suppression of fires on school property.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirty-four, to read as follows:

Section 34. *Payment for Fire Services; Public School*

2 *Property.*—Where a fire company or fire department neces-
3 sarily renders services in preventing or extinguishing
4 fires upon public school property situated beyond their
5 legal sphere of operation, the county board of education

6 may pay, as a consideration for said services, a reasonable
7 compensation to such fire company or fire department and
8 such expenditures therefor shall be made from the general
9 current expense fund as an incidental expense.
