House Bill No. 224

(By MR. HAGER and MR. ENGLAND)

[Passed March 14, 1953; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to meetings, quorums and the compensation of members of boards of education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four, article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 4. *Meetings; Quorum; Compensation of Mem-*
2 *bers.*—The board shall meet on the first Monday of July
3 and the first and third Tuesdays in August and at such
4 other times as the board may fix upon its records. The
5 board shall meet at its office on the first Monday in June
6 in each year and shall appoint the teachers for their dis-
7 trict. At which time, it shall be the duty of the superin-

8 tendent of schools to furnish each member of the board
9 an approved list of all qualified teachers for the schools
10 of said districts for the ensuing year.

11 Special meetings may be called by the president or any
12 three members, but no business shall be transacted other
13 than that designated in the call.

14 A majority of the members shall constitute the quorum
15 necessary for the transaction of official business.

16 Board members shall receive compensation at the rate
17 of fifteen dollars per meeting. But they shall not receive
18 pay for more than eighteen meetings in any one year.

19 Members shall also be paid, upon the presentation of
20 an itemized sworn statement, for all necessary traveling
21 expenses incurred on official business, at the order of the
22 board.
