AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, chapter one hundred forty, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine, fixing the salary of the judge of the domestic relations court of Cabell county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:


That section four, chapter one hundred forty, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 4. *Salary of Judge.*—The judge of the domestic
2 relations court of Cabell county shall receive for his ser-
3 vices nine thousand six hundred dollars, annually, payable
4 monthly in installments beginning on the first day of
5 January, one thousand nine hundred fifty-five, which
6 amount shall be provided for and paid by the county court,
7 out of the treasury of said county, which provision as to

8 salary shall not repeal the existing provision until the
9 said first day of January, one thousand nine hundred
10 fifty-five.

11 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent or in conflict with
12 this act are hereby repealed.



Chairman Senate Committee



Chairman House Committee


