House Bill No. 280

(By MR. GOSHORN)

[Passed March 12, 1953; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article three, chapter forty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to commissioners of accounts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article three, chapter forty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1. *Commissioners of Accounts.*—The county
2 court of each county shall appoint not more than four
3 commissioners of accounts, except that in counties in
4 which there exists a separate tribunal for police and fiscal
5 purposes, such tribunal shall appoint such commissioners
6 of accounts: *Provided*, That in Barbour county there shall
7 be appointed as aforesaid four commissioners of accounts,

8 not more than two of whom shall be from the same politi-
9 cal party: *Provided further*, That in Kanawha county
10 there shall be appointed as aforesaid eight commissioners
11 of accounts, not more than four of whom shall be from
12 the same political party.
