AN ACT to amend and reenact section thirty-three, article eight, chapter thirty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to fees, costs and expenses charged by the commissioner of banking for making examinations.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section thirty-three, article eight, chapter thirty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 33. *Fees, Costs and Expenses of Examinations.*—

- 2 (1) For making an examination within the state of any  
3 banking institution the commissioner of banking shall  
4 charge and collect from such institution and pay into the  
5 state treasury a fee of fifty dollars upon the first twenty-  
6 five thousand dollars of the assets as shown by the books

7 of the bank on the date of examination and six cents for  
8 each additional one thousand dollars of such assets.

9 (2) For making an examination within the state of any  
10 other corporation under his supervision or control, the  
11 commissioner of banking shall charge and collect from  
12 such corporation and pay into the state treasury the ac-  
13 tual and necessary costs and expenses incurred in connec-  
14 tion therewith, to be fixed and determined by the com-  
15 missioner.

16 (3) If any such examination be made at a place out-  
17 side of this state, the fees, costs and expenses shall be as  
18 above provided, except that there shall be an additional  
19 charge for each examination of twice the amount of the  
20 railroad fare from the city of Charleston to the place  
21 where the examination is made.

22 The commissioner of banking may maintain an action  
23 for the recovery of all such fees, costs and expenses in  
24 any court of competent jurisdiction.
