AN ACT to amend article twenty, chapter nineteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section eight-a, relating to the joint ownership, leasing, operation and maintenance of dog pounds by counties and municipalities, and the joint employment of dog wardens.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article twenty, chapter nineteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section eight-a, to read as follows:

Section 8-a. *Joint Ownership and Operation by Counties and Municipalities of Dog Pounds and Joint Employment of Dog Wardens.*—The county court of any county may contract with any municipality within the county

5 for the joint ownership, leasing, operation and mainte-
6 nance within the county of a dog pound and may jointly
7 employ a dog warden or dog wardens.
