AN ACT authorizing the county court of Marshall county to  
expend a sum not to exceed five thousand dollars per year  
in support of the 4-H program of the Marshall county fair  
organization from regular county levies.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Support of 4-H Program, Marshall County.*—

2 The county court of Marshall county is hereby author-  
3 ized to spend a sum of money not to exceed five thousand  
4 dollars per year in support of the 4-H program of the  
5 Marshall county fair organization from the moneys col-  
6 lected by the Marshall county court from regular county  
7 levies.
