House Bill No. 447

(By MR. McLAUGHLIN)

[Passed March 14, 1953; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article twelve, chapter sixty-two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, to be designated section five-a, relating to probation officer appointments in the fourteenth judicial circuit and in Wayne county in the twenty-fourth judicial circuit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article twelve, chapter sixty-two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, to be designated section five-a, to read as follows:

Section 5-a. *Probation Officers of Fourteenth Judicial*
2 *Circuit and of Wayne County; Salary and Expenses.*—The
3 judge of the circuit courts of the fourteenth judicial cir-
4 cuit and of the circuit court of Wayne county in the

5 twenty-fourth judicial circuit each is authorized to ap-
6 point a court probation officer to serve during the plea-
7 sure of the appointing judge, without first obtaining ap-
8 proval of the county courts of the counties of said judicial
9 circuit and of Wayne County, respectively, as provided
10 in section five of this article. Such appointment shall
11 be effective upon the entry of the appointment order in
12 the court order book. A certified copy of said order shall
13 be delivered to the county court of each of the counties
14 concerned and said county courts respectively, shall ar-
15 range for and appropriate funds for payment of and shall
16 pay the salary and expenses of such probation officer in
17 a manner consistent with contribution provisions of said
18 section five. The probation officers so appointed shall have
19 and may exercise all of the powers and perform all the
20 duties and services of probation officers as provided in
21 this article.
