[Passed March 12, 1953; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize and empower the judge of the circuit court of the seventeenth judicial circuit to employ a competent stenographer, defining duties, and providing for the manner of payment.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Stenographer for Seventeenth Circuit.*—The
2 circuit court of the seventeenth judicial circuit, or the
3 judge thereof in vacation, is hereby empowered and au-
4 thorized to employ and appoint a competent stenographer
5 to aid said judge in the performance of all his official
6 duties. Said appointment and employment of such stenog-
7 rapher may be made by the judge of said court by an
8 order entered of record in said court, and said stenog-
9 rapher so appointed shall hold office during the pleasure
10 of the court.

Sec. 2. *Stenographer's Salary.*—The compensation of
2 said stenographer shall be fixed by said judge at such sum
3 as he shall from time to time deem proper, and an amount
4 not to exceed one hundred twenty-five dollars per month,
5 but subject to approval by the county court of Monon-
6 galia county, shall be paid by said county court in addi-
7 tion to the amount paid out of the state treasury under
8 the authority of section six, article seven, chapter six of
9 the code of West Virginia, as amended.
