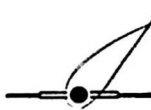

[Passed February 16, 1953; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact chapter two hundred eleven,
acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine
hundred fifty-one, fixing terms of the criminal court of
McDowell county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That chapter two hundred eleven, acts of the Legislature,
regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one, be
amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 11. *Terms of McDowell County Criminal Court.*

2 —There shall be four terms of said court held in each year,
3 commencing on the Tuesday following the second Monday
4 in the months of January, April and July and the first
5 Tuesday following the first Monday in the month of Oc-
6 tober. Adjourned and special terms of said court may be

7 called and held as provided for adjourned and special
8 terms of the circuit court.
