[Passed March 13, 1953; in effect July 1, 1953.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section seven, article two-a, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to salary and expenses of the state road commissioner.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seven, article two-a, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 7. *Salary and Expenses.*—The commissioner shall
2 receive an annual salary of nine thousand dollars, and the
3 necessary traveling expenses incident to the performance
4 of his duties. Requisition for traveling expenses shall be
5 accompanied by a sworn and itemized statement which
6 shall be filed with the auditor and permanently preserved
7 as a public record.
