Senate Bill No. 189

(By MR. MARTIN)

[Passed March 3, 1953; in effect July 1, 1953.]

AN ACT to make an appropriation out of the treasury, state fund general revenue, for the purpose of reimbursing Edward Beal, for expenses he incurred in connection with injury he sustained at Potomac State school of West Virginia university.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Appropriation for Edward Beal.*—There is
2 hereby appropriated from the state fund general revenue
3 the sum of two hundred fifty-five dollars and seventy-
4 three cents to reimburse him for expenses he incurred
5 as a result of medical expenses expended by him when
6 he was injured in the gymnasium of the Potomac State

7 school of West Virginia university at Keyser on Feb-
8 ruary eight, one thousand nine hundred fifty-two, when
9 a window fell from said gymnasium striking said Edward
10 Beal and causing him bodily injury.

Sec. 2. *Finding of Moral Obligation.*—It is hereby de-
2 clared to be the finding of the Legislature that this re-
3 imbursement is necessary to discharge a moral obligation
4 of the state of West Virginia.
