[Passed March 14, 1953; in effect July 1, 1953.]

AN ACT finding and declaring the claim of James Reynolds
against the state and its agency to be a moral obligation
of the state, and directing the auditor to issue warrant for
the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Finding and Declaring Claim of James Rey-*
2 *nolds Against the State and Its Agency to Be a Moral*
3 *Obligation of the State, and Directing Payment Thereof.*
4 —The Legislature has considered the findings of fact and
5 recommendations heretofore reported to it by the court
6 of claims concerning various claims against the state and
7 the agencies thereof, and in respect to the following claim

8 the Legislature adopts those findings of fact as its own,
9 and hereby declares it to be the moral obligation of the
10 state to pay such claim in the amount specified below,
11 and directs the auditor to issue warrant for the payment
12 thereof out of any funds appropriated and available for
13 the purpose.
